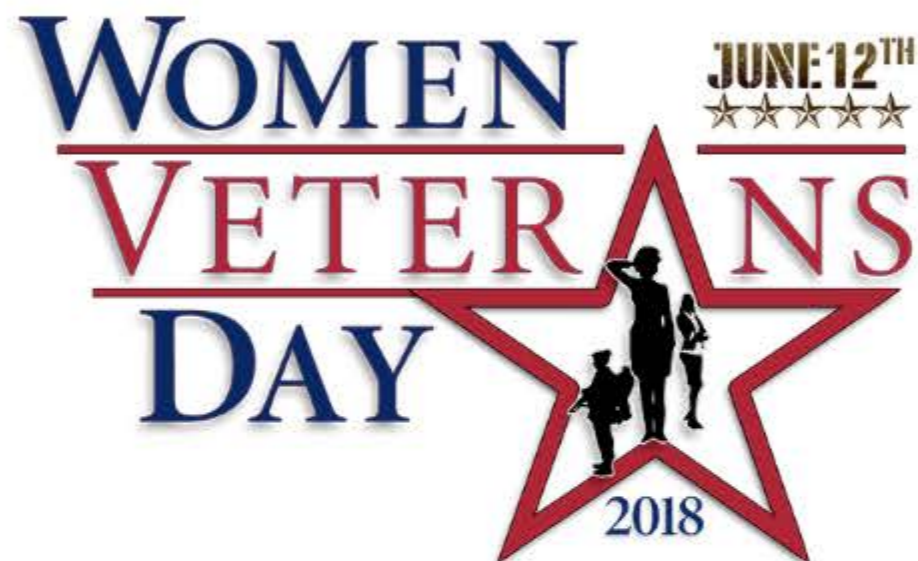

What: Recognition of the Women Veterans in the State of Texas

Why: To recognize the contribution of women who pledged to protect and serve the United States of America by joining the United States Armed Forces.

History: On June 12, 1948, President Harry S. Truman signed into law the Women's Armed Services Integration Act allowing women to serve as regular members of the military.
